General the Lord Richards is the Non Exec Chairman to the Arturius International board. He retired from his role as the Chief of Defence Staff, the professional head of the British armed forces and military strategic adviser to the British government, in July 2013.

Lord Richards's prestigious military career saw service across the world, including commanding roles in Afghanistan, Sierra Leone, East Timor and Germany. Before becoming Chief of the Defence Staff, he served as Chief of the General Staff and Commander-in-Chief of UK Land Forces in the period 2008–10. Prior to this he was Commander of the International Security Assistance Force in Afghanistan from 2006–07. His operational awards include a Mention in Despatches and Knight Commander of the Order of the Bath. This latter award was the first time an officer had received an operational knighthood since the Second World War.

Lord Richards brings immense diplomatic expertise and political acumen to Arturius International. His extensive experience of strategy and contemporary international affairs will add immense value to the Arturius International formula.

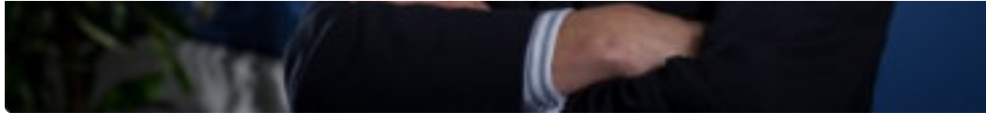
Cameron Macnish
